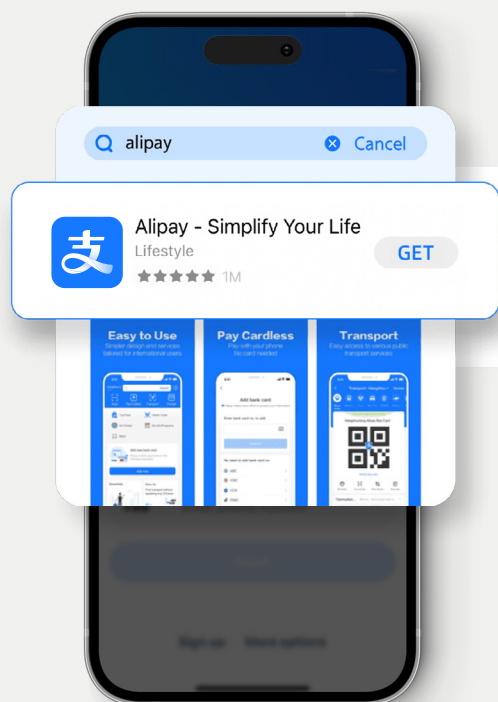
Link your eligible American Express® Card on your mobile.

1. Download and register for the Alipay App

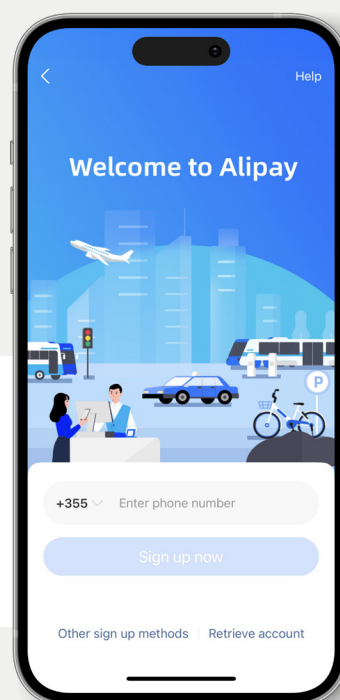

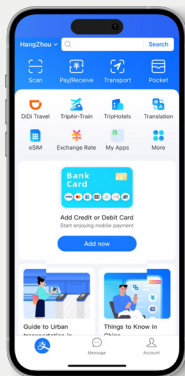
Search and download the 'Alipay' Application on your phone's App Store.

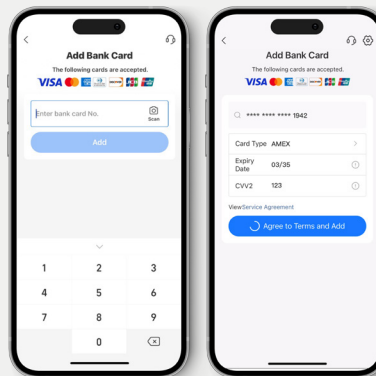


2. Link your eligible American Express Card

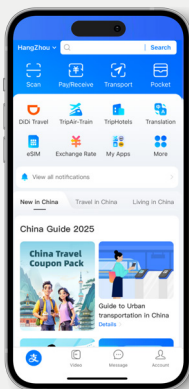
From the Alipay homepage, select 'Add now' from the center of the screen.

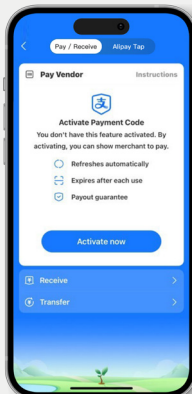
Enter your eligible American Express Card number and input the expiration date and CVV code (the 4-digit code on the front of your American Express Card).

3. Pay with Alipay (Chinese Mainland Wallet)



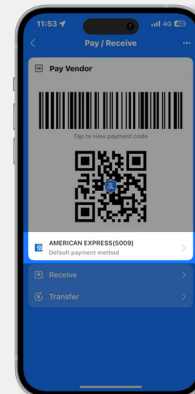

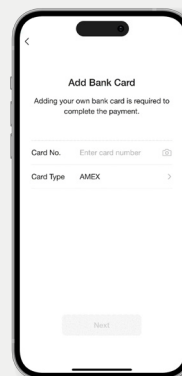
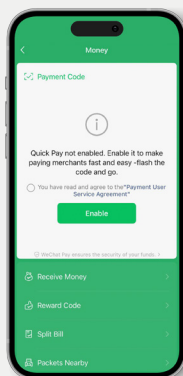


2. Link your eligible American Express Card



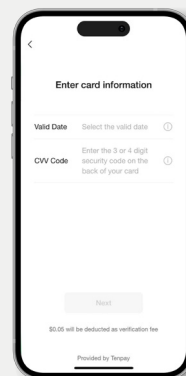

Select the + sign at the top right of the screen; then select 'Money' from the drop-down menu

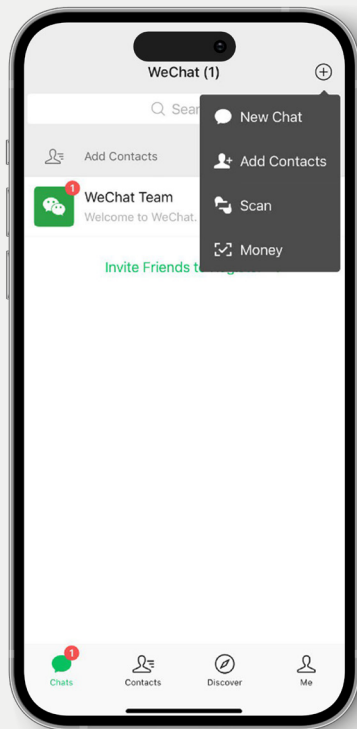

Enter your eligible American Express Card number and input the expiration date and CVV code (the 4-digit code on the front of your American Express Card).

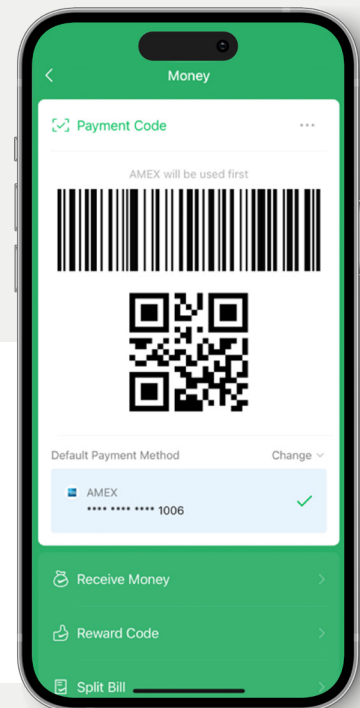


3. Pay with **WeChat** (Chinese Mainland Wallet)

Present the QR code to the merchant when paying. You can switch to a different American Express card by navigating to the ribbon immediately below the QR code and selecting another card.

Alipay and WeChat Pay charge a 3% handling fee for all international bank card transactions greater than 200 RMB. Transactions through Alipay and WeChat Pay will be billed in RMB, the local currency of the Chinese Mainland. Relevant foreign exchange charges will apply. All transactions on the Alipay and WeChat Pay mobile wallets will receive the base Membership Rewards® earn rate on eligible purchases on your American Express Card. In providing the digital wallet service, Alipay and WeChat Pay mobile wallets may ask for or collect your personal identifiable information (PII) including your name, phone number, and birth date under the local privacy laws of the Chinese Mainland. To comply with local regulations, Alipay and WeChat Pay mobile wallets requires identity verification for annual transaction values which exceed \$2,000 USD per account. Once your accumulated transaction value in Alipay and/or WeChat Pay mobile wallets reaches this threshold, you will be prompted to upload your passport information for identity verification purposes. Upon successful identity verification, your transaction limit will be raised to a single transaction maximum of \$5,000 USD and an annual transaction maximum of \$50,000 USD per account. American Express is not responsible for any such collection activity, nor are we party to or responsible for Alipay or WeChat Pay mobile wallet PII processing activities. Your minimum identity information and payment transaction information will be shared with American Express's China joint venture for China regulator reporting purposes.
