

Pay using Alipay while travelling in the Chinese Mainland


Link your eligible American Express® Corporate Card to Alipay (Chinese Mainland wallet) on your mobile.



American Express and Alipay have announced a new feature aimed at enhancing payment convenience for international travellers in the Chinese Mainland.* Follow the steps below to enjoy a seamless Amex payment experience in the Chinese Mainland.

*American Express® Cards issued by third parties outside of the Chinese Mainland are not eligible to be added to the Alipay Digital Wallet.

1. Download and register for the Alipay App


Search and download the 'Alipay' Application on your phone's App Store.

Select your local region, then enter your mobile phone number. You can also register with your email or Apple ID.




2. Link your eligible American Express Corporate Card


From the Alipay homepage, select 'Add now' from the center of the screen.


Enter your eligible American Express Card number and input the expiration date and CVV code (the 4-digit code on the front of your American Express Card).

3. Pay with Alipay (Chinese Mainland Wallet)





Select the 'Pay/Receive' icon from the Alipay homepage.

Press 'Activate now', then present the barcode/QR code when paying at a Merchant.

Then select your eligible American Express Corporate Card below the QR code to process your transaction.

American Express Cards issued by third parties outside of the Chinese mainland are not eligible to be added to the Alipay Digital Wallet. Alipay charges a 3% handling fee for all international bank card transactions greater than 200 RMB (~\$28 USD). Transactions through the Alipay Digital Wallet will be billed in RMB, the local currency of Mainland China. Relevant foreign exchange charges will apply. All transactions on the Alipay Digital Wallet will receive the base Membership Rewards® earn rate on eligible purchases on your Amex Card. In providing the digital wallet service, the Alipay Digital Wallet may ask for or collect your personal identifiable information (PII) including your name, phone number, and birth date under the local privacy laws of Mainland China. To comply with local regulations, Alipay requires identity verification for annual transaction values which exceed \$2,000 USD. Once your accumulated transaction value in the Alipay Digital Wallet reaches this threshold, you will be prompted to upload your passport information for identity verification purposes. This information will be shared with American Express's China joint venture for reporting purposes connected to KYC regulations. Upon successful identity verification, your transaction limit will be raised to a single transaction maximum of \$5,000 USD and an annual transaction maximum of \$50,000 USD. American Express is not responsible for any such collection activity, nor are we party to or responsible for Alipay Digital Wallet PII processing activities. American Express fraud control mechanisms are applied to all Alipay transactions which are in addition to Alipay's proprietary fraud prevention tools. Card Members retain all standard chargeback rights on Alipay transactions.
