

Corporate application activities in the U.S. will soon be moving to Global Apply for Card (GAFC).

U.S. Corporate application activities on Global Online Program Management (GOPM) | Apply for Card (AFC) are moving to GAFC, an upgraded, centralized, and more intuitive application experience.

All applications available on AFC will be available on GAFC. New GAFC features will include Corporate Guaranties, an option for Program Administrators to complete applications on behalf of employees, and other enhancements.

Soon after, GOPM AFC will be phased out.



This will happen in two phases:



PHASE 1

LAUNCH OF GAFC ENHANCEMENTS

and dual access to most features
(duration approximately 90 days)

Program Administrators who are authorized to approve U.S. applications on AFC will be given access to GAFC, if not already provided. AFC access keys will be available in GAFC when Phase 1 starts.

Program Administrators who use AFC are encouraged to start using GAFC to initiate and approve new applications.

Before the end of July, the capability for Program Administrators to complete applications on behalf of employees will no longer be available on AFC and can only be used on GAFC.

During this period, AFC will still be available to initiate applications with access keys. Continue to use @ Work Status Tracking to approve and submit AFC applications.

To modify any access keys during this period, edit the access key in GAFC instead of AFC. Any changes to access keys made in AFC will not be reflected in GAFC.



PHASE 2

VIEW & APPROVE APPLICATIONS

During this phase Program Administrators **can continue to use @ Work Status Tracking to view, approve, and submit applications already initiated on AFC.** All other capabilities for AFC applications will be turned off. Applications must be submitted by the end of Phase 2 to avoid being canceled. If canceled in AFC, a new application can be initiated on GAFC.

Use GAFC for all access key and new application activities.

All applications previously available on AFC can be initiated on GAFC.



THEREAFTER

AFC will be completely PHASED OUT

Any AFC applications still waiting for Program Administrator approval at the end of Phase 2 will be canceled.

Corporate applications that were previously available on AFC will be managed on one centralized platform: Global Apply for Card (GAFC).

Program Administrators will have one seamless experience to initiate, send, track, and approve digital applications for multiple markets.
