Get even more savings

Bluebiz² is the corporate loyalty programme for Air France and KLM. With each ticket used, your company earns blue credits that can be exchanged for tickets, upgrades and flight-related services. This way, you immediately save on your company's travel budget.

Bluebiz bonus

If you participate in the bluebiz programme, your company will earn a bluebiz bonus with the KLM American Express Corporate Card and/or Business Travel Account, which can amount to up to €2,000 per year.

This bonus is calculated on the basis of the annual expenditure on Air France and KLM flights³ made via the KLM American Express Corporate Cards and/or Business Travel Account.

Every €1,000 = 10 blue credits
for eligible flight expenses

The bonus is in addition to the blue credits your company already receives from KLM, on all booked flights with Air France, KLM and participating partners. The bonus is automatically credited to your company's bluebiz account at the end of each year.

Redeeming blue credits

Exchange your blue credits for tickets, upgrades and flight-related services, such as a more comfortable seat.

1 blue credit = €1

Your bluebiz number gives you access to all online functionalities via the KLM website. You can check your blue credit balance, redeem blue credits or change your details.

Example

1 flight with KLM €1000²
Value of ticket €500
Carrier surcharge €200

= 2,800 Miles



FLYING BLUE MILES ON SPENDING WITH THE KLM AMERICAN EXPRESS CORPORATE CARD

€10 spent on Air France, KLM, Transavia and Hertz = 15 Miles



Example

Purchased at KLM: €700

= 1,050 extra Miles

€10 for other expenditures = 10 Miles



Example

Purchased at hotel: €100

= 100 extra Miles
