American Express asked some of their Shop Small Ambassadors (both past and present) to share their insider tips on the everyday small businesses that they can't live without.


The Shop Small campaign aims to support small businesses by encouraging the nation to back their high street and enjoy the benefits of 'shopping small', whatever their budget.






